Minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting
April 15, 2007**

The Board of Directors of The Eller Family Association met April 15, 2007 at 9:00 P.M. Eastern time via telephone hookup. The following members were present: Tom Eller, President; Eric Eller, Vice President; Roger Eller, Secretary-Treasurer; Anna Marie Bliss, Director; and 2007-09 Director-Nominees Nancy Eller, Joe C. Eller and Lois Hardy. Lois is also the 2007 Conference Coordinator.

President Tom welcomed those present to the meeting and asked the secretary to read the minutes of the last meeting. Roger read the minutes of the January 14, 2007 meeting which were approved as read. Tom reviewed the dates of the board meetings for the next three meetings, which are scheduled for July 21, 2007, October 14, 2007, and January 13, 2008. The July 21 meeting will be held at the 2007 Conference at Akron, Ohio; the others will be by telephone.

Roger gave the financial report as follows: cash balance July 1, 2006 was: checking account \$4,911.71, certificate of deposit \$10,000, for a total of \$14,911.71. The receipts

for the nine months period ended March 31, 2007 includes dues of \$2,125 and sale of GME books \$80 for a total of \$2,205. Disbursements for the nine months includes printing and mailing of The Eller Chronicles \$1,216.42, postage \$23.49, web site \$179.55, fidelity bond premium \$183, deposit on tee shirts \$300, for total disbursements of \$1,902.46; and a balance at March 31, 2007 of \$15,214.25, of which \$3,214.25 is checking and \$12,000 certificate of deposit. Roger noted that the certificate of deposit matures April 22, 2007 and that the current renewal rate is 5.14% for a seven months term. The financial report was approved as submitted.

President Tom asked Lois for her report on the 2007 Conference. She said that she has received several registrations and that everything is progressing toward our having an excellent conference. She said that she has commitments for a couple of speakers, and Tom said that he also has a speaker, Dr. Freed, who is well qualified to speak on the "DNA" subject. Lois indicated that Karen Pelzman from Paris, TN has requested to talk to the membership about having the 2009 conference in Nashville, TN. Lois said that she called Van Eller this afternoon to ask how about Betty. She is in a convalescent nursing home recovering from both a stroke and heart attack. Van says that she is making some progress, albeit slow. She is having a problem with her equilibrium, and therefore trouble walking.

Eric said that he has nothing new to report about the Eller Website.

Joe C. said that he will be on a trip to Estonia during the conference and, regrettably, will be unable to be at the conference in Akron. His wife is from Estonia and during the several trips that they have been there, they have become good friends with Hillar Eller, who has traced his ancestry back thirteen generations, but not out of the country of Estonia. Joe commented that this DNA technology could produce some embarrassing results.

Anna Marie reported that she had sent out thirty letters to Eller names obtained from the telephone book and received only one reply, which was to inform Anna that the Eller addressee was dead.

Tom reported that he had tried in vain to get in touch with the lady whose name Lynn had given to Tom as potentially providing assistance with the newsletter. However, Tom says that he has not given up on contacting her.

Tom said that the February newsletter contained on pages 6 and 7 the several proposed amendments to the by-laws; and, that without reiterating those changes, the May newsletter will refer to the February issue of the Chronicles to the membership.

Roger reported that we have about sixty copies of the book *George Michael Eller and Descendants of His in America*, by James W. Hook, and suggested putting these on sale. After some discussion, the board decided to announce a twenty percent discount and sell the books for \$32 each. Any remaining books will be available at the conference in Akron at the price of \$32.

Tom asked if there were any further business to consider; there being none, the meeting adjourned at 10:02 P.M.
